Grunts 101:

- Classic Fish
 - Basic "fish-like " shape
 - o Relatively large mouth
 - Rounded back shape, flat bottom
 - Notched tail

- Common name is derived from the unusual "grunt" sound produced when teeth grinding deep within their throats is amplified by the air bladder.
 - Related to Snapper
 - No canine teeth
 - Schoolers

Basic Grunts:



- Bluestriped Grunt 18"
 - Blue and yellow stripes on head and body
 - Dark tail with translucent yellow margins



- Caesar Grunt 15"
 - Silver and yellow stripes
 - Dark tail with translucent margins (not yellow)
 - Often very shiny compared to the Bluestriped
 - Render all your gold to Caesar



- White Grunt– 18"
 - Blue and yellow stripes on head, none on body
 - White tail with no border

Smaller Grunts:



- Smallmouth Grunt- 9"
 - 5 or 6 yellow stripes go all the way from top of body to bottom
 - Fins yellow



- Striped Grunt- 9"
 - Normally have five yellow to brown stripes on upper body (none on belly)
 - o Fins white or opaque



• French Grunt- 10"

Yellow stripes below lateral line set on a diagonal.
All fins yellow. "designer stripes" or "cigarette smoke"

Broadstriped Grunts



• Tomate - 8"

- Prominent yellow to bronze stripe runs form snout through eye to base of tail; another thinner stripe on back.
- o Fins pale.
- Black spot on base of tail (not always present)



Cottonwick- 10"

- Bold black stripe on dorsal fin continues to form a "v" on tail (not present in pale phase)
- Think CottonVick
- Black stripe begins on snout, runs across eye and continues to tail; color may change to yellow behind eye



- Spanish Grunt- 10"
 - Bold black stripes on upper body
 - Yellow green dorsal hump
 - Yellow saddle or spot on base of tail
 - o Beefy body and lips like a Spanish Conquistador

Weird Grunts



- Porkfish-12"
 - Bright yellow gold
 - o Two bold diagonal bands (bacon) on head
 - High back profile



- Sailors Choice 17"
 - Silvery gray with rows of darker spots on each scale, makes the scales stand out (like miniature sails)
 - O Dark tail and dorsal fin, prominent lateral line
 - Larger eye, golden edges

New Members



- Boga 9"
 - Two dorsal fins close set
 - Midbody stripe curves slightly above side of fish (not straight)



- Bonnetmouth 9"
 - Two dorsal fins set far apart
 - Midbody stripe straight down side of fish
