<ul> <li>Queen Angelfish – Holacanthus ciliaris</li> <li>Blue crown with light blue jewels in it</li> <li>Yellow tail (the Queen has gold)</li> <li>Juvenile – body bars are curved</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>French Angelfish – Pomacanthus paru</li> <li>Scales dipped in French's Mustard</li> <li>Often in pairs</li> <li>Juvenile has a yellow O on the tail – think of Oooooh La La!</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Reef Butterflyfish – Chaetodon sedentarius</li> <li>Black bar through eye and on rear body</li> <li>Imagine "ReeF" written on side of fish, with the bars being part of the letters R and F (I know it's a stretch)</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Spotfin Butterflyfish – Chaetodon occellatus</li> <li>Yellow fins, with small black spot on edge of dorsal fin</li> <li>Night coloring different!</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Harlequin Bass – Serranus tigrinus</li> <li>Black and White harlequin pattern</li> <li>Some hints of pale yellow</li> <li>Pointy head</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Coney – Cephalopholis fulva</li> <li>Many color variations: Reddish brown, to brown, to bicolor, to yellow.</li> <li>2 dots on lower lip (Coney Island tattoo)</li> <li>2 dots at base of tail</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Tobaccofish – Serranus tabacarius</li> <li>U-shaped border on tail is like a dental imprint "chewing tobacco"</li> <li>Orange to brown color is the color of tobacco</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Honeycomb Cowfish – Acanthostracion polygonius</li> <li>Spines above eyes (cowfish have these, not trunkfish though)</li> <li>Honeycomb pattern over body</li> <li>Blueish greenish in color</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Scrawled Cowfish – Acanthostracion quadricornis</li> <li>Blue-green to yellow base color</li> <li>Scrawly blue markings over body</li> <li>Blue line goes from mouth, along bottom of side, to anal fin</li> <li>Spines above eyes (cowfish have these, not trunkfish though)</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Black Durgon – Melichthys niger</li> <li>Black body with pale blue lines at base of dorsal and anal fins</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Queen Triggerfish – Balistes vetula</li> <li>Long, trailing tips to dorsal and tail fins</li> <li>2 thick blue stripes on face</li> <li>Small lines around the eye (Queen's eye makeup)</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Glasseye Snapper – Heteropriocanthus cruentatus</li> <li>Silver bars on reddish body.</li> <li>Silvery marks can be faint, and change instantly</li> <li>Large red eye</li> </ul>
