Black 'n' Blue	
	Blue Rockfish – Worry lines on forehead, tear streaks from crying because he's feeling "Blue". Bluish color, sharp angled anal fin.
	Black Rockfish – Smooth forehead with no lines, dark area under dorsal fin with light colored blotches. Black on silver background.
The Three Amigos	
	Gopher Rockfish - White "Gopher" hole on dorsal. White mark on front of dorsal fin that spreads onto body. All white markings have distinct edges to them. Fins have yellow/brown color to them. Mottled down to belly.
	Copper Rockfish – Thick white line along lateral line that goes mid-body to tail. Fins are light colored, belly is white. White markings don't have distinct edges. "Copper" tubing halfway back. Thick white line. Light underbelly.
	Black and Yellow Rockfish - Not common, look for Black and Yellow spots, and pattern on tail.
Step up to the Bar	
	Pile Perch – "Dock piling" on back doesn't go all the way to its belly. Deeply forked tail. White dot where pile meets dorsal fin.
	Sargo – SoCal fish. Backwards S shape on gill. Black bar is tallest part of fish. Dark and well defined bar.

	Rubberlip Perch – Large lips, botox injections. Similar to Pile perch, but tail not
	forked. Wider bodied. Bar can be very faint.
Those Stripey Guys	
	Black Perch — Thin, dark bars, black moustache, blue lining to anal fin, large scales near pectoral fin.
	Rainbow Perch — Bars look like drips from the Sherman-Williams paint sign, fatter at the top, thinner at the bottom, and not going all the way down. Irridescent colors. Flat underbelly, bright blue trim on ventral fins.
	Zebra Perch – SoCal fish. Thick bodied fish with many black bars on sides. White underbelly. Seachub family.

	Coralline Sculpin – Longer snout, large lips, flattened cirri.
	Snubnose Sculpin – Blunt snout, large rough scales on back.
	Scalyhead Sculpin – Cirri on forehead. Several cirri at mouth. White dot at base of tail.
