

REEF DISCOVERY TOUR Led by Paul Humann World-renowned Marine Life Author and Underwater Photographer Key Largo, Florida Horizon Divers and Ramada Inn June 21-28, 2008 8 days/7 nights, 24 divers max

REEF Discovery Tours are designed for divers and snorkelers who are interested in learning more about marine life and the environment to enhance their diving experiences. Each day, world-renowned author/photographer and REEF co-founder, Paul Humann, will be giving presentations about reef fish and creature identification, their ecology and behaviors, and environmental issues facing the underwater world.

Per person: \$1200.00 per diver, double occupancy

Package Includes: 7 nights accommodations at the Ramada Inn, 5 days of 2-tank boat dives with Horizon Divers, with an additional two evening dives TBD during the week, and daily continental breakfast. Wednesday is a non-diving/tourist day but if participants would like to dive this day, there is an additional expense.

General Information: The Florida Keys is a popular dive destination and represents the largest coral reef in the Continental U.S. The magnificent natural coral reefs a few miles offshore are world famous for their beauty. Underwater treasures await divers and snorkelers who enjoy the colorful, tranquil marine life in these clear, tepid, azure waters. Visitors to Key Largo quickly understand why it is billed as the "Dive Capital of the World" and there are plenty of other treasures nearby to explore such as the Everglades, hardwood hammocks and many great restaurants. We will dive with Horizon Divers, a long-time REEF Field Station and well known for their great service and knowledge of the Florida Keys. The group will be staying at the Ramada Inn, within walking distance to the dive shop and dock. Getting There: The closest airports to Key Largo are Miami (MIA) and Ft. Lauderdale (FLL); it is then approximately 1.5 to 2.0 hours by car to Key Largo. There is no scheduled transportation service to/from the airport. There is a shuttle from either Miami or Fort Lauderdale airports called the Keys Shuttle <u>http://keysshuttle.50megs.com/</u>. Rental cars are available at the airports, and are highly recommended in order to sightsee while in Key Largo.

More about Discovery Tours: The week is for all, beginner and experienced divers/snorkelers alike, who are interested in learning about marine life and seeing more on their dives/snorkels. Paul Humann, who wrote the *Reef Identification* series guidebooks, is leading the Discovery Tour! Paul will be presenting daily, late afternoon, informative slide programs teaching reef fish and creature identification, how these animals function and their behavior, enhancing the participants' knowledge and enjoyment of diving. Discover not only what to look for on beautiful reefs, but also the exciting finds that can me made out on the sand flats, in gorgonian fields and areas of muck and rubble. Environmental topics and ways recreational divers can play a role in preserving our marine life heritage will also be on the agenda. There will be pre- and post-dive discussions with Paul to call attention to specific fish, creatures and behaviors to discover.

Deposit Policy: \$300 per person to hold your spot. Following receipt of your deposit, we will send you an invoice for the balance and final payment is due no later than April 1, 2008.

Cancellation Policy: Full refund minus \$50 fee if canceled prior to 60 days of departure. Between 60-45 days deposit is non-refundable, between 45-30 days 50% of package price is non-refundable, and within 30 days the entire package is non-refundable. There are no refunds on unused dives.

Minimums: Most REEf trips require a minimum number of participants. Trips are subject to cancellation if the minimum number of participants is not met. In the event of a trip cancellation, REEF or Horizon Divers are not responsible for airline tickets purchased for travel. We strongly suggest purchasing trip insurance. All prices are subject to change until ticketed and paid in full.
