Cubbyu 5-8 inches	Usually dark with very thin stripes, like a dark cubby hole Juvenile has a "cubby-hole" between the eyes.
RISSE Highhat 5-8 inches	Broad black and white stripes. Juvenile has a high dorsal fin like a "high hat" on a lady.
RESE Juvenile Jackknife-fish 5-8 mehes	Shaped like a "Jackknife". The juvenile often has yellow on it and the nose only has a small stripe.
RISSE Juvenile Spotted Drum	Has a large "Spot" on the nose. The dorsal fin is feathery like the feather on a "Drum" major's hat. It's a "spotted drum" major.

ripes.
e colorful spot on this wrasse "Slipped" back to the gill ver. sually darker than the painted wrasse.
ue squiggles on the fins.
lults have a lyre-shaped tail, unless it has been bitten off.
e second dorsal and anal fin have a gradual slope.
orsal and anal fins are very steep – like a big wave in the Ocean".
ns are uniform gray color with no markings.
il almost straight up and down.
lid "Yellow Tail" from juvenile through adult.
e back of the dorsal and anal fins are yellow. Bright blue "shape on the head fades as the fish matures.
llow margin on the tail, like "Sunshine" peeking out from a oud.
e juvenile has yellow across the back, like the morning unshine" peeking over the horizon.

RISSE Cocoa Damselfish 3-4 inches	Scales have a dark edge that looks like hot "cocoa" dripping
	over the sides of a mug.
	Adult color highly variable. Juvenile is bright blue and yellow. It usually has a dark "cocoa" puff on the base of the tail.
RISE Threespot Damselfish 3-4 inches	Large spot on bases of the tail and pectoral fin. Yellow crescent over the eye.
	The juvenile is bright yellow with spots on the dorsal and caudal peduncle.
RIGGE Bluerunner 12-34 inches	Uniform silvery "Blue" color. Tips of tail has dark spots.
RISCE Bar Jack 8-14 inches	Dark blue and black "Bar" runs from back to lower lobe of tail.
Red Snapper 6-24 inches	Tail is solid pink or red. Anal fin comes to a point.
	Generally "RED" or pink all over, but may have a dark spot below the dorsal fin and a white belly.
Mahogany Snapper 7-12 inches	Dark "Mahogany" red margin on the tail. Anal fin is rounded.
