Stick through the slots dotted and scored on top and sides of lionfish...

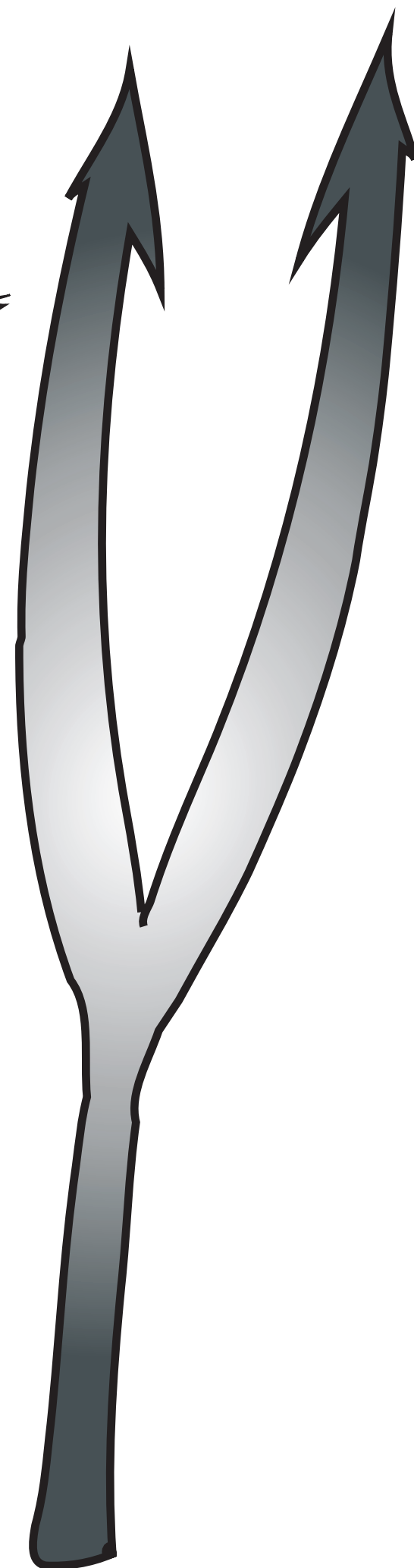
Cut along outside all solid lines!!

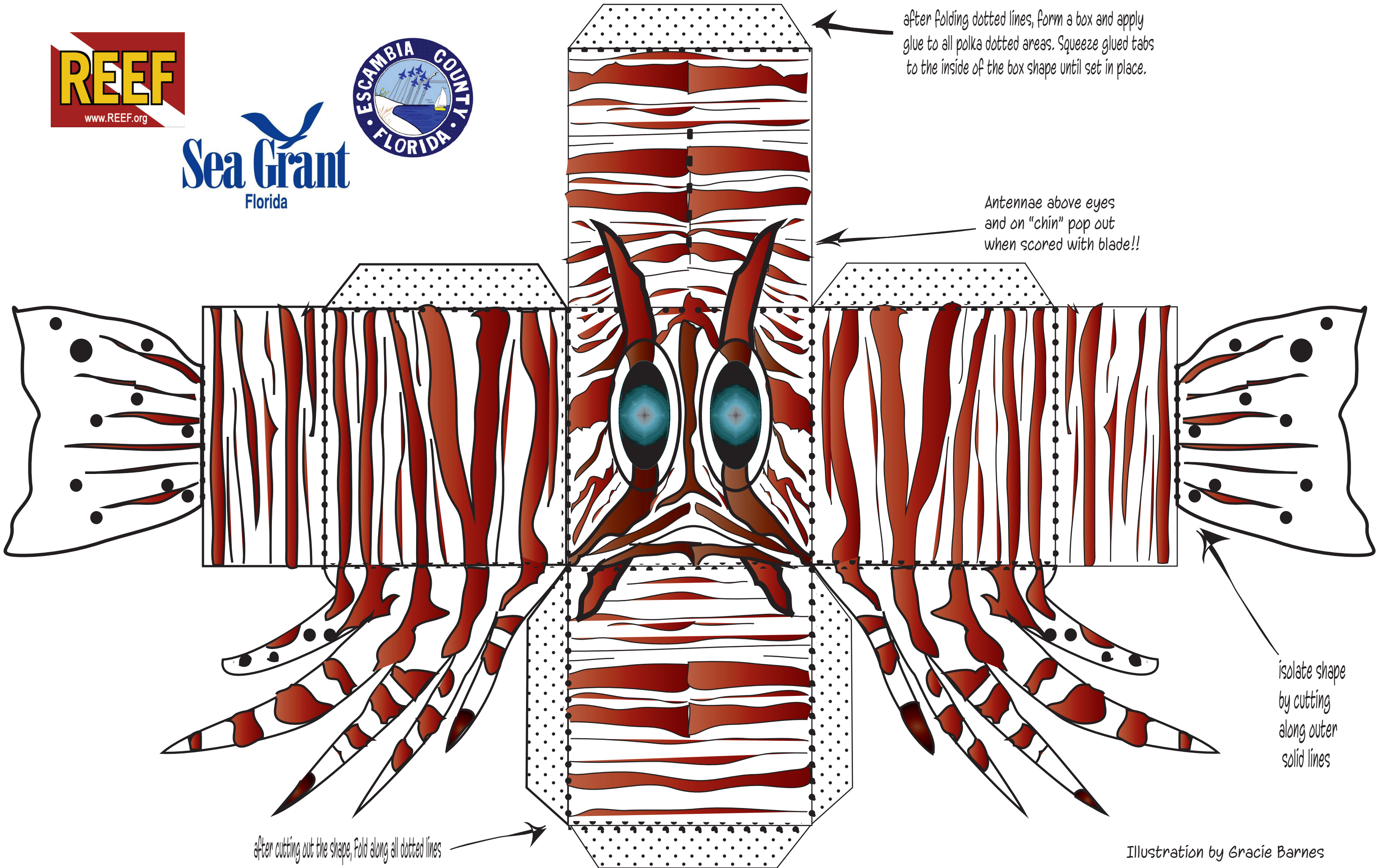
Fold at dotted line. Glue the halves together ...

wedge into cut on top of box toy.

after folding dotted lines, form a box and apply glue to all polka dotted areas. Squeeze glued tabs to the inside of the box shape until set in place.

Antennae above eyes and on "chin" pop out when scored with blade!!

isolate shape by cutting along outer solid lines

after cutting out the shape, Fold along all dotted lines
