### **REEF INVASIVE SPECIES PROGRAM 2023 SCHEDULE**

### **COLLECTING & HANDLING WORKSHOPS**

Classroom workshops & free lionfish charter dives will be offered as part of an Earth Day Celebration in April & the Florida Keys Derby in September toincrease the local community participation in invasive removal efforts.

#### JEWELRY WORKSHOPS

Lionfish fin jewelry making workshops will be held quarterly throughout the year at Amoray Cay Resort & at REEF campus to promote the marketability of invasive lionfish & provide incentives for removals.

#### **CULINARY EVENTS**

A Lionfish Food and Wine event will be hosted at a local Florida Keys restaurant in Aprilto promote invasive lionfish as a eco-friendly culinary delicacy. Public lionfish tasting &cooking demonstrations will also be offered at Mote's OceanFest(April)& Florida Keys Festival(September).

### FLORIDA KEYS LIONFISH SWEEP

Divers will be encouraged to remove lionfish between April through June & drop them off at REEF campus for a chance to be entered in raffles and win cash prizes. Lionfish will be used in education activities & tasting events.

### **EDUCATION & OUTREACH PROGRAMS**

More that 30 classroom, virtual & outreach activities will reach hundreds of students (grades K-12 & university) & community membersthroughout the year. Participantswill learn about the threat oflionfish & other invasive species & the role they can play in prevention & management.

### **EXOTIC SPECIES SIGHTINGS PROGRAM**

REEF's Exotic Species Sightings Program will be promoted to the public and during all outreach and education programs. All nonnative sightings will be shared with partners and stakeholders including Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary, USGS & Frost Science Museum & removals will be implemented when possible.

### DEEP WATER LIONFISH TRAPPING RESEARCH

REEF's research team will continue to work on testing the efficacy of managing high densities of deep water lionfish populations off the Florida Keys with traps designed specifically to target lionfish with limited by catch.

### FLORIDA KEYS LIONFISH DERBY & FESTIVAL

The 2023 Florida Keys Lionfish Derby & Festival will promote large scale local removal of lionfish. The festival will include 25 environmentally-minded vendors, live music & lionfish demonstrations & tastings at the picturesque Postcard Inn Resort & Marina in Islamorada, FL September 8- 10, 2023.

All program events will be promoted through REEF's social media platforms, website updates, REEF's eNews letters to our 70,000 members & local community emails. Advertising & promotion is supported through Monroe County TourismDevelopment Council Destination Event grant & the TDC Cultural Umbrella Grant.



## REEF INVASIVE SPECIES PROGRAM BACKGROUND

Invasive lionfish (*Pterois volitans*) are an ever-increasing environmental problem throughout the Atlantic, Caribbean, and Gulf of Mexico. Their predation on native fish and invertebrates can cause dramatic declines in these populations. These venomous, invasive fish have few local predators and breed year-round, allowing for rapid population expansion. Lionfish derbies and workshops are a useful tool in stimulating local control efforts and encouraging reports

and removal of other non-native marine species.

### **DERBIES AND WORKSHOPS**

A lionfish derby is a team competition aimed to collect as many lionfish as possible. Prizes are awarded to the teams with the most. biggest, and smallest lionfish caught. Our derby includes a day-long festival with: cooking demonstrations, free lionfish tastings, educational booths, live music, and kids activities. The festival is promoted to REEF's 70,000 members and advertised through local and media. We offer collecting and lionfish handling workshops with collection dives to train divers and increase removal efforts and jewelry workshops.

## OUR GOALS: INCREASE EDUCATION AND AWARENESS

REEF's lionfish derbies, workshops and education programs serve to educate participants and the public and raise awareness of the problem. Significant local, national, and international media coverage of derby events has helped facilitate education to those not geographically connected to the invaded range.



### REMOVE SIGNIFICANT NUMBERS OF LIONFISH

Research studies indicate that even single day removal events can be highly effective in lowering the local lionfish population. REEF has facilitated the removal of over 60,000 lionfish through lionfish derbies, workshops, and research.

### TRAIN DIVERS, ENCOURAGE ONGOING REMOVALS

REEF derbies help build a volunteer removal force by equipping divers with necessary skills, and by encouraging ongoing removals. Local education programs engage the next generation of ocean stewards. And encourage reports and rapid removal of nonnative sightings.

### PROVIDE SAMPLES FOR RESEARCH

Collecting data on local lionfish populations year after year helps scientists assess how the population is changing over time. Samples are provided to regional scientists for ecological and biological studies. Collaborations formed between fishermen, scientists, and managers at these derby events are vital to informing and improving management efforts.

### HELP DEVELOP MARKETS

Cooking and fillet demonstrations at derbies provide free tastings to the public and demonstrate it verstatility as a culinary delicacy. REEF will host jewelry workshops and a culinary event in April of 2023 to further promote and expande the commercial market of lionfish.
