# 2024 REEF INVASIVE SPECIES PROGRAM

#### **COLLECTING & HANDLING WORKSHOPS**

Classroom workshops & free lionfish charter dives will be offered as part of an Earth Day Celebration in April &the Florida Keys Derby to increase the local community participation in invasive removal efforts.

#### **JEWELRY WORKSHOPS**

Lionfish fin jewelry making workshops will be held quarterly throughout the year at REEF campus to promote the marketability of invasive lionfish & provide incentives for removals.

#### **CULINARY EVENTS**

A Lionfish Food and Wine event will be hosted at a local Florida Keys restaurant to promote invasive lionfish as a eco-friendly culinary delicacy. Public lionfish tasting & cooking demonstrations will also beoffered at Mote's OceanFest & the Florida Keys Lionfish Derby & Festival.

#### **EDUCATION & OUTREACH PROGRAMS**

More that 30 classroom, virtual & outreach activities will reach hundreds of students(grades K-12 & university) & community members throughout the year. Participantswill learn about the threat of lionfish & other invasive species & the role they can play in prevention & management.

#### **EXOTIC SPECIES SIGHTINGS PROGRAM**

REEF's Exotic Species Sightings Program will be promoted to the public and during all outreach and education programs. All nonnative sightings will be shared with partners and stakeholders including Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary, USGS & Frost Science Museum and removals will be implemented when possible.

### DEEP WATER LIONFISH TRAPPING RESEARCH

REEF's research team will continue to work on testing the efficacy of managing high densities of deepwater lionfish populations off the Florida Keys with traps designed specifically to target lionfish with limited by catch.

## FLORIDA KEYS LIONFISH DERBY & FESTIVAL

The 2024 Florida Keys Lionfish Derby & Festival will promote large scale local removal of lionfish. The festival will include 25 environmentally—minded vendors, live music & lionfish demonstrations & tastings at the picturesque Postcard Inn Resort & Marina in Islamorada, FL August 18, 2024.
