Participants are encouraged to report their fish sightings as part of the REEF Fish Survey Project.

General Information: Bonaire, located in the south Caribbean, is one of the ABC islands - Aruba, Bonaire and Curacao. Bonaire offers the best shore diving in the world. Paired with some awesome boat diving, this is the perfect diving holiday. The waters around Bonaire are designated as an official Marine Park, which extends all the way around Bonaire. Reefs start right at the water's edge, making it an ideal place for snorkelers and shore diving. A rental truck is included for each booked room to enable ample opportunities for shore diving and exploring the island. Abundant and diverse fish species offer the diver plenty to see on each dive. Eight of the top ten most diverse sites in the REEF database are in Bonaire. This is a great destination! Water temperature is in the low 80's. Getting There: There are several airlines that serve Bonaire Flamingo airport (BON). The resort will pick you upon arrival and transport you to the hotel, where your rental truck will be waiting for you. Please let us know if you need help with flights. If you book your own flights, please send us your schedule so that we can arrange your transfers and let the hotel know your arrival time. Please schedule your flight to be in Bonaire by 3:00pm on Saturday so that you are not late for the first seminar.

Deposit Policy: \$350 per person to hold your spot. You will receive an invoice and final payment is due by August 1, 2007.

Cancellation Policy: Full refund minus a \$50 fee if canceled prior to 60 days before departure. Cancellation between 60-45 days, the deposit is non-refundable, between 45-30 days 50% of package price is non-refundable, and within 30 days the entire package price is non-refundable. There are no refunds on unused dive portions of your trip.

Minimums: Most REEF trips require a minimum number of participants. Trips are subject to cancellation if the minimum requirements are not met.
