Body shape

Oval

Oblong, elongate

Head

Pointed

Blunter

Black Shoulder spot

Absent

Present, obvious

Body color

Usually pale grey, especially belly

Uniform dark brown

Tail shape

Obviously forked

Lyre shaped, concave

Dorsal fin outer edge

Yellow

Blue

Rear edge of dorsal fin

Small white spot in lower corner

Large white blotch

Tail color

mid-grey top and bottom edges, translucent center, tips may be yellow

Dark brown with white center

Behavior

ranges far from the substrate... 10m or more

stays close to substrate (within 2m, usually < 1m).

Habitat

broad range of habitats, with low to high levels of shelter

High level of shelter only; prefers top edges of drop-offs and of large coral heads

Note: black blotch on inside of pectoral fin base visible in *C multilineata* in photos is present in both species.
