After three dives each day, Paul will be teaching fish identification and how to easily conduct REEF fish surveys during your dives.

Diving and Lodging Information: Utila is the smallest of the three Bay Islands off the coast of Honduras. The extensive reefs of Utila provide for an exciting and varied experience with over 70 buoyed sites around the island to choose from. Dive sites range from the awe-inspiring sheer walls that drop to over 3000ft to shallow fringing reefs that start at 5 ft and drop down to 100 feet. While we won't be there during whale shark "season", there is always a chance we will see one of these magnificent creatures. Unlimited shore diving is also available from the resort beach. Getting There: You can fly into San Pedro Sula or Roatan then take an air transfer to the island of Utila. Continental, American, Delta and Taca all fly to Utila. The inter-island flight to Utila is about \$160 r/t. Please let us know if you need assistance with your air. If you book your own airfare please let us know your schedule. Please plan your flights accordingly to you arrive on Utila by 4:00pm on Saturday so that you are on time for the first evening seminar.

Deposit Policy: \$300 per person to hold your spot. Following receipt of your deposit, we will send you an invoice for the balance and final payment if due no later than August 15, 2007.

Cancellation Policy: Full refund minus \$50 if canceled prior to 60 days before departure. Between 60-30 days 50% of package price is non-refundable, and within 30 days the entire package is non-refundable. There are no refunds on unused portions of your trip.

Minimums: Most REEf trips require a minimum number of participants. Trips are subject to cancellation if the minimum requirements are not met.
